Abstrakt

The subject of thesis is examining the impact of prevention activities implemented through comprehensive programs crime prevention at local level, the number of crimes committed and the number of minors and young offenders in selected regions. This is a total of 97 towns in the Czech Republic, where prevention programs were implemented more than five years.

The first part of the work - theoretical - it is aimed at creation preventive activities in the Czech Republic and the subsequent developments in the period from 1996 to 2008. There are also summarized and described the most important and inter-departmental programs implemented during the same period.

Part Two - empirical - contains information about research that was conducted in two phases. In the first phase was carried out research on trends in crime as exhaustively specified period, and five or ten years from the first implementation of preventive activities. The second phase focused on the annual change in the number of registered crimes and the number of minors and juvenile offenders and the subsequent classification of the regions in the five specified categories.

In the final section are acknowledged and discussed the results of the research identified the impact of preventive activities and possibilities of further use of the work.
