

The aim of this project is to introduce a “System of early intervention“ using methodology assigned by the Home Office. The System of early intervention is a process of work and communication in the area of social and legal protection of children and juvenils and fraud prevention. I am describing my reasons for the creation of this project and its general set up for the Czech Republic. The project is relevant to the problems of endangered and delinquent children and juveniles, and I am explaining the terms related to the subject in this introduction accordingly. In the next section I will target the development of fraud in the Czech Republic and I will mention some examples of foreign countries for comparison. Due to several departments being involved in the execution of this project, I am further introducing their activity in connection with the system. After introduction with the project on a general level, I will focus on concrete examples of work in the way that is being implemented in the Town district Prague 2.

To comply with the title of my work, I am practically addressing the comparison of the System of early intervention in the nine towns in which the project has already been implemented. I have undertaken SWOT analysis and have determined its strong and weak points, opportunities and threats. I have then discussed these with the representatives of individual locations. Even though the methodology is set uniformly, I have on the basis of the interview evaluated a number of different approaches and opinions. In conclusion, I am introducing a case report of a girl under long-term review with the Authority of social and legal child protection.
