

## Summary

### Legal regulation of forest protection

The purpose of this Master's Degree Thesis is to examine the legal regulation of forest protection. The thesis focuses mainly on current forest legislation in the Czech Republic. The main purpose of this study is to ascertain whether the existing forest protection legislation is efficient and sufficient. And I also caused two general parts of legal regulation which are protection land designated to fulfil the function of forest and protection of forest against harmful factors. The work is divided into nine chapters. Chapter One defines the forest as a whole, its functions and questions of its protection. Chapter Two ascertains the legal regulation of international forest protection, European and national level. There is examined the national development of legal regulation of the forest protection. The aim of Chapter Three is to look at criteria used to divide forests into individual categories. Chapter Four defines the aims of protection land designated to fulfil the function of forest. Chapter Five examines the protection of forest against harmful factors. The following Chapter Six defines the main legal regulation of forest economics. The aim of Chapter Seven is to describe the public use of forests. The next chapter, Chapter number Eight, talks about the general responsibilities in legal regulation of forest protection. In the last Chapter Nine are the subjects forest protection defined.

There is a summary at the end of my work. There are described the main problems of the legal regulation of forest protection. There is also caused whether the legal regulation of forest protection is efficient and sufficient.

In my opinion the answer is yes – the legal regulation of forest protection is sufficient, but it is necessary to novelize the legal regulation. There is also suggested and recommended the state ownership of all forests instead private ownership.
