## **RESUME**

The issue of the ban on interrogation pursuant to Section 99 (2) of the Penal is a very complex one. This is due to the fact that the obligation to maintain confidentiality is a fairly broad notion; searching on the Internet you will be able to find up to 10 standards mentioning confidentiality, especially confidentiality stipulated by law. Section 99 of the Penal Code is also related to the provisions of Section 8 of the Penal Code, amended on several occasions.

I have tried to analyze some of the problems related to frequent examples of confidentiality as I have found out that in practice this issue is unclear and has not been dealt with in detail. This thesis aims at calling attention on the theory vs. practice.

I personally believe that this issue is still much underestimated both in theory and in practice.
