

This thesis deals with the butchers corporation in Jaromer and its functioning in 1621 – 1678 and in Hradec Kralove it is focused on the meat shops and transactions with them by persons of different status in years 1559 – 1661. The thesis results from the book of pacts about rents and sells of the meat shops, stored in the State District Archive in Hradec Kralove, and from the book of records from the meetings of the butchers corporation in 1621 – 1678, stored in the State District Archive in Nachod. In the thesis, there is drawn out the situation of the cities, city administrative and corporation's situation. The butchers corporation in Jaromer is mainly monitored in connection with the thirty-years war and with the economic situation of people after this war. There is also drawn out the routine usual for accepting of the new members of the corporation and the procedure of the corporation's meeting. In Hradec Kralove, the emphasis is placed on the transactions with the meat shops, economic situation of their owners and their social position.
