

This bachelor thesis „Presidency as a representative of the EU in Crisis situations“ focus on the role of presidency as representative of Common Foreign policy in European Union. Thesis is divided into three main parts. The first part describe the main theories of presidency. Second part of work focuses on the French presidency and its role in the Russia - Georgian conflict and the Czech presidency and its role in the conflict in the Gaza. The principal part compare Czech presidency and French presidency and their behavior in these conflicts.
