

This bachelor thesis deals with the Opočno castle located in Eastern Bohemia and development of manor interiors.

The first chapter introduces the town history to the reader, the development of the castle from a stronghold and its first owners. The following two chapters present two most influential dynasties in the castle history who were responsible for the today's style of the castle. Thanks to the first dynasty of Trčka, the castle earned its Renaissance style. The second dynasty of Colloredo-Mansfeld paid its attention to petite treatments of the building and of the castle interiors. Furthermore, there are chronologically introduced all members of these dynasties who became owners of the castle during a few centuries.

In order to describe the development of the interiors, it is very important to have knowledge of the building development of the castle which is the theme of following chapter. From the very beginning the castle went through many essential changes and building design which influenced also its interior structures. These changes are described there in accordance with the individual style periods.

This chapter is followed by another passage in this thesis which deals with the development of the interior equipment since the reign of the dynasty of Trčka z Lípy till the present. This document attempts to render individual interior changes according to building development and subsequently depicts their nowadays style which comes from the last change at the turn of 19th and 20th century.
