

This work includes the history of the church of Saint Mary Victorious and the Infant Jesus of Prague and the places where his cult is held and the ways how the popularity of the Prague Infant spread all around the world.

The first part is about the history of the church of Saint Mary Victorious, including entries about former Lutheran church of The Holy Trinity which was rebuilt and thus the contemporary church was developed after the former owners Lutherans were banished and the new owners Barefooted Carmelites came. During the reign of Josef II the Carmelite monastery was abandoned and the church was administered by Maltese Knights. After the year 1990 the Carmelites returned. The following part deals with the history of the Holy Infant of Prague, with his origins before he came to Prague and his story during the Thirty Years' War. The basic information of his owners and Barefooted Carmelites are included. The last part contains the description of the Prague Infant, how he is dressed and how the cult is spread around the Czech country and later all over the world.
