

"Transcendental Archeology - Ontology - Metaphysics: methodological alternatives in the phenomenological philosophy Husserl's

Summary: Our starting point is the thesis that perspectives of the phenomenological projects consist in the further development of the phenomenological doctrine of method. This study treats three methodological strategies of Edmund Husserl's late philosophy. As research-projects they build three methodological alternatives within the bounds of Husserl's phenomenology: the "transcendental archeology of consciousness" (reconstruction of the primal institutions and dismantling analysis of the genesis of consciousness), the "mundane ontology" (interpretation of the concordance and of the pre-givenness of the experience), and the "metaphysics of the primal facticity" (modalizing of the facticity of the having-the-world). From this perspective we will analyze the methodological problems, the content problems and the problems of the systematic of Husserl's phenomenology.
