

Diploma thesis „National Radicalism in Hungary – Jobbik political party” deals with a political party in contemporary Hungary called (Movement for better Hungary –Jobbik). The aim is to place the party into a theoretical frame. Jobbik became important after the European parliament elections, when the party gained nearly 15% and 3 seats. In April 2010 Jobbik successfully entered the Hungarian parliament with nearly 17% and 47 seat.
