

Abstract:

This master thesis analyses the development and shape of residential suburbanization in north-east part of Prague hinterland – municipality with extended powers Brandýs nad Labem-Stará Boleslav - using data about new housing construction in the period of 1997-2008 from Czech Statistical Office and data from Register of Enumeration Districts and Buildings. The thesis shows development of spatial arrangement of suburban housing in the period 1992-2008 in municipality with extended powers Brandýs nad Labem-Stará Boleslav. The thesis includes case studies of residential structure in several villages from north-east part of Prague hinterland: Jenštejn, Klecany Zdiby and Zlonín. It is monitored area of villages, sizes of plots and built-up areas and types of buildings in these locations, with emphasis on new buildings
