

Anotation

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The bachelor's thesis is a pilot study which describes a quality of life patients with carcinoma of pancreas. I describe an anatomy and physiology of pancreas in the theoretic part, then carcinoma of pancreas is described, together with its risk factors, diagnostic procedures, treatment and outcome of the therapy. Furthermore, I focus in a support of suffered patients by this disorder, an importance of port systems and so called Easypumps which are used for applications of the chemotherapy. The next term quality of life is specified in theoretic part of the study.

The experiential part includes the inquiry by the help of questionnaire QLQ- C30 and QLQ-PAN26 which are standardly intent on quality of life in patients with carcinoma of pancreas. The study includes patients who undergone palliative gastrointestinal operation with palliative chemotherapy. Checklists were completed as a whole 30 patients. Decreasing of quality of life dominates in the results of the QLQ-C30 questionnaire, which was expressed by median of score: general health status 50; somatic functioning 66,67; emotional functioning 66,67; working ability 50; cognitive functioning 58,33; social functioning 66,67. The questionnaire QLQ-PAN 26 outcomes express by the median of score in symptom scales: pancreas-specific pain 58,33; digestive problems 58,33; intestine dysfunction 100, liver dysfunction 75; poor body image 58,33; dissatisfaction with care 33,33; sexual dysfunction 33,33.
