

Rigorous thesis "Novimii' Vaclav Chab (1895 - 1983)" deals with an image of Vaclav Chab, czech publicist, writer and translator. Rigorous thesis describes important moments of Chabs life in chronological sequence. First part of the thesis analysis Chabs growing up and attend to his participation at czechoslovak foreign legion in Russia during First world war. After his return back to the country, he started to work as a journalist at weekly paper Legionarsky smer and then at daily paper Narodni osvobozeni. During the Second world war he was very shortly active in paper Narodni prace and then in paper Nase zpravy and then was obliged to stay in illegality. In the very first beginning of the Prague revolution in May 1945, he was active in re-issuing of Narodni osvobozeni. The biggest attention is paid to his journalist profession at Narodni osvobozeni. Early in 1950's was Chab employed in Statni pedagogicke nakladatelstvi, where he was active even in retiring age. Rigorous thesis also paid appropriate attention to many of Chabs prosaic publications, in which he mostly describes historical subjects. He is also known for publications with anti-nazi themes. His translation activities are not omitted from this thesis. Rigorous thesis also documents Chab's relationship with dr. Lev Sychrava and aim to deals with his political opinions.
