

ABSTRACT

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The name of Thesis: Charles University – the Faculty of Pharmacy within the years 2000/2001 – 2002.

The goal of the work: Following previous historical research described in theses in the past, the goal is to collect, sort out and carry out the overall analysis of activities concerning Faculty of Pharmacy in Hradec Králové in the given period. My aim was to retain the development and progress in as detailed way as possible.

Used methods: The analysis of materials retaining activities of the faculty in given period. The study of organisational and real principles in the List of lectures at Faculty of Pharmacy Hradec Králové, analytic research and the study of Annual reports on the college activity.

The analysis and study of materials obtained at different departments, the Centre of Scientific and Librarian Information, Study and Scientific Department of the Faculty of Pharmacy in Hradec Králové play an outstanding role in the process of research.

The results: Synthesizing view of the organisational area and leading of Faculty of Pharmacy of Charles University including staff problems of the University. The attention was paid to the structure of taught subjects and to the lecturers in different terms of the study programme Pharmacy and Medical Bioanalysis. The figures obtained during the two monitored years were compared. I monitored the number of students at special trainings, I created a list of graduation theses, dissertation theses and inaugural dissertations. Next I analysed the number of students and graduates of the University. In my thesis I recorded the research activity, foreign contacts and social organisations which worked in the monitored period.

Conclusion: The overall number of professional workers in given period slightly increased from 155 in academic year 2000/2001 to 158 in the following year. In the third term the subject Ecology was cancelled and then there were only personal changes of the lecturers. The number of students who took part in special training in 1st, 2nd and 3rd terms was higher in 2000/2001. The number of students who took part in 4th and 5th terms was higher in 2001/2002. The interest in the study programme Pharmacy and Medical Bioanalysis (by Entrance proceedings) increased and the number of graduates increased as well.
