Abstract

This paper is engaged in teenagers and their attitude towards the extremist organisation.

The author sums up basic connotations of terms used in connection with the extremism. She acquaints readers with the best known extremist organisation in Czech republic and their methods how to address other people, namely teenagers.

However, the text is focused especially on the real situation and that's why it contains an empirical part dedicated to research, where she submits and evaluates the dates obtained from questionnaires.

The aim of this text is an analyse of the attitude of teenagers (without the right to vote) to the extremist organisation and vice versa the attitude of this organisation to the teenagers.
