Title of the thesis:	Do information cascades arise easier under time pressure? Experimental approach.

OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

This Master thesis examines the role of information cascades in the decision making process of individuals using experimental approach. The author tests numerous hypotheses concerning the effect of public information on decision making process. This thesis contains complex overview of the role of experiments in economics, theory of information cascades. The author uses an experiment to identify the effect of publicly available information on private decision. I strongly believe that this method is appropriate as it allows for full control of the behavior of the participants.

Concerning the econometric evaluation of the data, the author provides extended theoretical introduction into the econometrics of limited dependent variable and problem of selection. For the purpose of publication I would suggest shortening and simplifying this part and focusing more on the limitation and the assumptions of the identification strategy that is implemented.

Generally, I believe that this thesis is a very good start for PhD. dissertation, but it needs to be shortened substantially.
