#### **OVERALL ASSESSMENT** (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

The thesis concerns the history of economic thought focusing on theories on capital, describing individual milestones in the theory's development and examining various ideas of prominent econmist connected to the topic.

The key advantage of this paper is a really clear and legible way it is written, employing an excelent level of English. Combined with the descriptive (even narrative) nature of the subject, this makes the paper a suitable summary for any students interested in an introduction to the theories on Capital. However, given the scope of the work it would be better to narrow its name to something as "Selected topics from the theory of capital" because it, in my oppinion, does not cover all of the prominent schools and thoughts on capital.

As the biggest objection to this paper, I need to state, that omission of all left-wing oriented economic theories concerning capital and other economic giants such as J.M.Keyness, although feasible, needs to be properly justified (the statement: "Other famous names were omitted for not fully complying with the frame of our work: Karl Marx or John Maynard Keynes." Is definitely not sufficient here).

I also need to mention that authors understanding to the topic is a prerequisite, not an outcome of the study, and should not be therefore mentioned as an achievement (which has been done in the conclusion).

The thesis is also, by definition, lacking much of author's own contribution to the topic as it is built to a large extent on past research and thought.

On the other hand, the author has proven to be not only quite lettered but also to be able to connect and compare various approaches and ideas to a logical and structured paper in a way which is, in my oppinion, surpassing expectations for a Bachelor's thesis.

I would definitely recommend this paper to any student interested in the theory of capital.

I do recommend this thesis for the defense. In the case of successful defense, I recommend "výborně" (excellent, 1).

Suggested question for defense: Why are K. Marx, J.M.Keyness and other prominent exponents of capital theory excluded from the paper?
