OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

This is an original, well-executed thesis. The author uses the family of generalized autoregressive conditional heteroscedasticity models to investigate the effect on exchange rate changes on stock market volatility in selected EU new member countries. Radek shows that (with some exemptions) exchange rate depreciation contributes to the increased stock market volatility. This has some rationale, as EU new member countries exhibit trend real exchange rate appreciation mainly due to its catching-up process to the old members.

The author has a good grasp on time series econometrics modeling and has shown ability to work independently on a large-scale project. The thesis has a standard structure, it is well-written and literature is well-cited. The results are well interpreted and discussed.

I strongly recommend the thesis for the defense and suggest grade A. I also suggest a distinction from the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences for an extraordinarily good BA thesis.
