## Late Motherhood from Demographic Point of View (Example of the Czech and Slovak Republic)

## Abstract

The thesis thematically refers the issue of late motherhood in the Czech and Slovak Republics from the twenties of the twentieth century to the present from a demographic point of view. It describes the changes that have occurred during the observed years as to fertility of women aged over 35, using selected demographic indicators.
