OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

Lenka has decided to examine the role of confidence indicators for business fluctuations in the Czech Republic. There are a number of important policy issues related to confidence indicators. For example, OECD recently created a leading indicator comprising of many underlying variables, which are likely to signal near-term economic developments. OECD has included the consumer confidence indicator, but not business confidence indicator for the Czech Republic. Lenka thesis shows that this is a wrong way to proceed. In fact, business confidence indicators are shown to be able to forecast near-term economic activity reasonably well, while this is not the case for the consumer confidence, which carries less forward-looking information. Clearly, there is an important policy aspect in the thesis.

Nevertheless, the good policy story that Lenka provides is not the only assets in her thesis. The thesis is extremely well written with great care. It almost reads as a journal article. This is really exceptional and shows that Lenka has put enormous effort into delivering outstanding thesis.

Lenka has mastered all important forecasting techniques that are typically used in macroeconomic analysis. It is nice that she uses the proper forecast evaluation tests for nested models, which is typically not the case in many academic papers.

As I said, it was a great joy to read the thesis and I suggest the grade A. In addition, I recommend the distinction from the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences for an extraordinarily good MA thesis.
