Abstract:

The aim of this thesis is to map the psychosocial characteristics of adolescents using

drugs while subject to therapeutic intervention in connection with noticing changes in their

identity.

The theoretical part is divided into three chapters. The first chapter cites the

characteristic signs of adolescence relating to biological, cognitive, emotional and

psychosocial developmental changes. The content of the second chapter is the formation of

identity as a key theme of adolescence. In the third chapter, dedicated to the specifics of drug

using in adolescence, themes relating to the origins of addiction, the roles of psychosocial

factors and rehabilitation possibilities are discussed.

The empirical part presents the research, processed research data from Safety Line

conversations on the theme of addiction, research data from questionnaires and conversations

with 41 adolescent drug users who entered an educational-therapy stay in the Alternativa

department, SVP Klíčov and research data from a case interpretation study.
