<b>Title of the thesis:</b>	Foreign Direct Investment in Mongolia – Its determining factors and policies

## **OVERALL ASSESSMENT** (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

The thesis is a good descriptive and analytical work on Foreign Direct Investment in Mongolia in 1990-2010. Mongolia showed to be one of the fastest growing country in the World and FDI played an important role in the development of the country.

The regression analysis of FDI inflow showed a positive relation between FDI inflows, DI and GDP. Even though the number of variables was too small, the basic assumptions were checked and the the model showed a good fit of data.

Some academic writing rules were not met:

- Phrases like „I will analyse“ and „my thesis“ (page 9) are not acceptable and had to be changed by „We will analyse“ or „It will be analysed“ and „the/this thesis“.
- Some typos appeared in the text: : „1.2.5 The Ecletic Theory An eclectic theory“ (page 21)
- Instead of Cobb-Douglas model, there was used „the Coubb-Douglass model“/
- List of references did not meet the rules of correct order of Author, Name, Year, Publication, etc.
  - o Adam Smith. 1776. “Inquiry into the Nature and Causes of the Wealth of Nation”
  - o Ohlin, B. 1933. “Interregional and International Trade” (page 53)

The correct order and information provided: PŘÍJMENÍ, Jméno autora. *Název : podnázev.* Vydání. Místo vydání : Název nakladatelství, rok vydání. Počet stran. ISBN.

Suggested question for the defense is:

- “What are the other spheres for development for Mongolia and what is to be changed to achieve the desired result as soon as possible?”

In the case of successful defense, I recommend “ **v ý b o r n ě**” (excellent, 1).
