

Abstract

This thesis deals with the use of conjunctions *bis*, *bevor* and *ehe* in the present German language. The characterization of them in grammar books and selected textbooks is compared, special attention is given to the difference between anteriority and posteriority and the synonymity between conjunctions *bevor* and *ehe*. There are also concerned the problems of translation of these conjunctions into Czech. One part is dedicated to the searching of sentences which are related with the future and in which occur conjunctions *bis*, *bevor* and *ehe* in the sense of anteriority. With conjunctions *bevor* and *ehe* the use of implicit negation is crucial.
