OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

The thesis is a well-written piece of work, where the author consistently pursues a research topic from stating hypotheses to a conclusion drawn from own analysis. The topic is a certainly interesting one and it offers an alternative point of view on the problem of economic growth and convergence between countries. The author begins with an extensive literature overview that includes not only established authors, but also more recent papers and publications, which allows for an optimal introduction to the problem.

In the chapter about a theoretical framework, the author clearly describes several firm characteristics and identifies their significance for the model. The chosen characteristics seem to be appropriate to link a firm to an institutional framework without having an overspecified model.

Institutional topics are often quite difficult to write in the sense of having the right data. This is, however, not the case of this thesis. The author demonstrated an excellent work with data, when the data necessary for the analysis come from an already existing dataset created by EBRD. Thanks to this, the data have a legitimate origin and are in a sufficient amount.

The author carefully applies econometric models on the data and correctly pays attention to the analysis of the data and their appropriateness for the chosen econometric models. This demonstrates the author's knowledge of the applied methods. Although the thesis is well-written and the manuscript form is consistent throughout the thesis, I would suggest only a minor improvement in using a better tool to write equations.
