Resumé v anglickém jazyce

Presented dissertation in detail deals with victim of criminal acts and her role in the science discipline called criminalistic victimology. Victim is a very important authority by the origin and in the progress of the crime. In the most of cases is victim participating in reporting crimes to police, investigation and judicial proceedings of committed offence. I concentrated my attention on the relationship between victim and perpetrator, which can be seen in many levels – from shallow and fleeting contact to very intimate realtionship. I also devoted to victim's participation on the origin of criminalistic tracks and on the reporting crimes to police. In my dissertation I also said the most common reasons, why victims didn't report committed offence. Very important is also the role of victim in the itself investigation and her cooperation at specific investigative acts like confrontation and recognition. One part of my work is about providing help to victims from the state and from non-state organizations. I also engage in new law about victims of criminal acts, which is already hearing.

This dissertation is primarily adressed to the professional public, especially for operatives in that organizations, which working with victims and helping them. Victimology is a relative young science field, but it deserves our attention. That's why I consider very useful to know basic facts and actualities about this interesting discipline – and it applies to everybody.
