

## **Abstract**

The theme of this bachelor thesis/work is the development of a child with visual impairment and how to work with them. The work consists of theoretical, practical part and the annexes. The theoretical part is focused on the development of the child and how can this handicap influence its evolution. I also briefly mentioned/characterised the most common children's visual diagnosis. One of these chapters is focused on cerebral palsy – the most frequently type of handicap that can be accompanied eye disorder. The space in this work is devoted to the early care focused on the child with some visual and combined handicap.

The practical part of the work consists of two case studies, the first one about the boy with visual and combined disability, and the other one about the boy with the purely visual handicap. In conclusion, both these studies are compared from the using methods point of view and from the providing services in the early care.
