ABSTRACT:

The thesis deals with teaching of syntax in language education at lower secondary

schools between the years 1918–1939. It verifies to what extent the education was affected by

social, pedagogical, didactic and linguistic factors. It analyzes the presentation of syntax in

contemporary prescriptive grammar books, monitors how much syntax was implemented in

the contemporary curriculum for lower secondary schools and it also focuses on the syntactic

topics presented by methodological manuals for students of teaching and teachers. In

particular, this thesis examines how the authors of the Czech Language textbooks, for lower

secondary school pupils, presented the syntactic topics. The surveys have shown that syntax

was, in this period, the focus of attention of: linguists, educationalists and methodists. Syntax

was an integral part of language teaching and was properly presented in their textbooks. The

surveys have shown that we can use many parts of these textbooks as high-quality sources of

inspiration.
