

Abstract:

In the year of 2007 has been in Brandýs nad Labem – Vrábí „U Vodojemu“ (Central Bohemia) carried out an archeological exploration in the process of which has been uncovered many objects of human skeletal remains of varied kinds dated from the early bronze age. It has been found not only the burial site of the early Únětice culture but also human skeletal remains in the settlement holes, two graves in the base of the settlement holes, a barrow with a stone wreath in a preserved cultural layer and a ditch with several human bones. From the barrow and the ditch originated five radiocarbon dates that disagree with dating of these objects based on ceramics typology.
