The object of my Diploma work is demonstration of the juggling influence on the coordinating abilities and psychomotorics of man or more precisely on children with hearing impairments.

The chapter called Motor development and movement describes movement, operating motor mechanisms, generally motor abilities and psychomotorics. There are mainly used literature information resource.

Further we find characterization of notion juggling. The work itself reflects in its history, describes signification of juggling for man and accounts what way itself learn juggling skills.

A group of nine hearing impairment children gets by about twelve juggling lessons under coaching of lector in research part of the work. There are used various methods - observation, testing of motoric abilities, study of electronic information resources, experiment, practice and dialogues.

Motor abilities testing and observation results predicate improvement in various motor abilities by almost all tested children (all children involved in the experiment).
