

The theme of this thesis is the history of two transports, transports D1 and Dm dispatched september 6 1943 from ghetto Terezín to Auschwitz.

It is possible to find a lot of information in many publications, but this thesis introduces this subject through testimonies of eyewitnesses.

Starting with the family background, continuing with deportation to Theresienstadt from where the transports were dispatched. Concerning the transport to Auschwitz, I elaborated its characteristics looking at the age and sex of the transported inmates.

Due to the witness's testimonies, I tried to concentrate on the history of two day's journey to the biggest extermination camp during the second world war. And the eyewitness's testimonies are illustrating all the welcoming ceremony, the disinfection, tattoo and dormitory allocation.

In my thesis, I would like to describe the Terezin inmates' biannual stay in family camp B IIb, tragical death of 3 792 of them at night of 8 to 9 March 1944, seeking to recreate the Dr. Mengele's list of medical personnel and twins.

Finally, I would like to emphasise the fate of 41 survivors of those transports.
