

Abstract

Supervision over financial market in the context of the supervision reform in the European Union

The aim of this thesis is to analyze the scope of regulation and financial supervision over financial market in the context of the supervision reform in the European Union. The orderly functioning and integrity of financial markets are the basic conditions on the stability of the financial system. The author uses a historical-empirical method to address the legislation of European reform of supervision and to analyze its scope.
