## ABSTRACT

The topic of this thesis is *Film as a Reflection of the Social Situation (in the Perspective of Sociological Analysis).* Its aim is to look at the issue of the film from a sociological point of view. This work consists of a theoretical and practical part. The theoretical part describes basic approaches to the film as they appeared during the 20<sup>th</sup> century in selected disciplines and sociology. Thus, the theory contains rather a basic overview of the possible starting-points for working with film. The next part of this work is a practical research project, which is dealing with a specific area of the Czech historical film in the late sixties of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The aim of the second part is to link theoretical principles with their practical use in the social context of the Czechoslovakia in the sixties of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The practical part, in which four Czech historical films were analyzed, confirms the essential idea of this thesis – the film is the reflection of the social reality.
