OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

I have served as superviser for this thesis but Jean has worked absolutely autonomously.

The main strength of this thesis is that it breaks some stereotypes. Jean concentrates on corruption in developing countries and it gives him freedom for mentioning even some positive impacts corruption may have.

He starts with definition of corruption and shows that there may be different political, moral and economic links and perceptions of the former. He applies and illustrates some of the concepts in the case study of Haiti. For his quantitative empirical study in Chapter 3, he uses two measures of corruption, CPI and "Control of Corruption Index".

I have some miner problems with the econometric part. It would be interesting to know the results of tests of standard assumptions, e.g. homoskedasticity. I do not understand the interpretation on page 40, this ought to be discussed during defence.

There are some miner formal mistakes; e.g. symbols on page 23 are not defined and the use of word "probity" in chapter 3 is misleading – thanks to the econometric context.

To summarize: I think that this thesis fulfills IES standards for bachelor theses and I recommend it for defence.
