Abstract

Title: Historical and Philosophical Context of the Art of Archery in Japan

Objectives:

The objective of this thesis is to describe Japanese martial art *kyudo* and introduce it to the wide public with the emphasis on the historical context and its relation to philosophical and religious systems.
