

The main aims are fates of the member of Czechoslovak foreign troops during the Second world war, lieutenant colonel Josef Šimůnek. He and many other thousands left his country and fought with Czechoslovak army in Poland, in the French Campaign in 1940. In the Great Britain he passed in parachute training and finally was deployed with Czechoslovak armored brigade at French port Dunkerque.
