

Abstract (in English):

Feminization of nouns describing professions and titles became a much debated question after the feminist movement had started to talk about language androcentrism in public in the seventies. The objective of feminization is to provide women with social visibility, which regards mainly women occupying important posts and functions. In spite of objections of both sociological and linguistic character, the process made rapid headway over the past few decades and many feminized nouns have become common.
