

Abstract

Bachelor thesis „Aspiration of Children from Children’s Homes“ discusses family plans and dreams of children from children’s homes, who don’t live in family environment, which is one of the main socialization agencies and also origin of ideas of future life. Main purpose of this thesis is to illustrate differences between children from childrens homes and children from families. Survey of children in children’s home above 15 years old was made for this thesis (N=127). Survey focuses on four main areas of family life: relationships, marriage, parenthood and distribution of roles in family. Other three datasets from surveys of future plans of childrens from families were analyzed. Frequency and correlations analysis were used and results of these two groups were compared together. It was revealed that plans of children from children’s homes and children from families varies. Results show that children from children’s homes are less inclined to future family life. There was also no evidence of linkage between age at which children were institutionalized and their future family plans.
