OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

In his thesis, Václav Korbel studies cheating behavior. To do so, he uses methods of experimental economics in the field among high school students. The main contribution to the existing literature is the focus on decision-making not only of individuals but also of teams/groups.

The experiment is based on the Fischbacher&Heusi (2008) design where participant throw a dice to determine their payoff and report the result without being monitored. There are several interesting results. Some but not all children cheat. Older students were found to cheat more than younger students. Younger students cheat more in groups. Older groups do not cheat more on average, but when they cheat they are more likely to do so to the maximum possible extent.

The thesis is of high quality. The research questions are clearly described and important (link between age and cheating behavior, differences between individuals and groups). Václav links his research to the relevant existing literature. The experiment has been carefully designed and implemented and allows to test the hypotheses. The econometric methods are appropriate and the manuscript is well structured and easy to follow.

I am happy to recommend the thesis for the defence and suggest grade A (výborně, 1). I also recommend to the defence committee to consider awarding the thesis a distinction for an extraordinarily good master thesis.
