**Summary** 

This work deals with politeness, politeness strategies and thanking and accepting

thanks in the Czech Republic. At first, the thesis processes the issue from a theoretical point

of view, there are presented the findings and theories of Czech and foreign linguists, who are

interested in politeness and communication, several approaches toward polite or impolite
