

Abstract:

Bachelor thesis *Comparison of the United Kingdom policy towards the Palestinian question in 1936-1939 and 1945-1948* compares the policy of the United Kingdom to Palestine in the periods defined by years 1936-1939 and 1945-1948. It focuses on the differences between the compared periods and analyses their causes. It is questioning what were the reasons which led the British government to adopt the different policies in these periods.
