

Abstract

The aim of the bachelor thesis is mainly to make an analysis of political speeches and official documents of two South African political parties, National Party and Economic Freedom Fighters, with a discursive analysis as a methodology. The focus of the thesis is on the discourse of justification which concentrates on justification of own existence and claim on representation. This claim on representation is then analysed with regards to a declared group which the party claims to represent and to which, at least, these politics are supposed to serve. The part of the analysis is also a matter of consistence of the rhetoric.
