

The Dark Green World. Radical environmentalism in Czech republic after 1989

ABSTRACT

Since 1970' environmental movement has been an important social actor. However it never has been an homogeneous and monolithic movement, but it has represented conglomerate of different approaches and currents, strategies and tactics which they were often in mutual contradictions too. This thesis focus on czech environmental movement after 1989 and especially on the radical ecologist activities. By using qualitative research it tries to map and to re-construct radical ecologist activities within a framework of international radical environmentalism. The thesis strives to open critical discussion about radical ecology in the czech context.
