

Summary

This work deals with the events of the Jizera front, which significantly influenced the Austrian North Army campaign against the Prussian armies in 1866. On Jizera front has gradually formed so-called the Jizera Army Group, which was formed by the Austrian Ist Army Corps, the Austrian 1st Light Cavalry Division and Saxon Army Corps. This army group in parts gradually faced attacking Prussian 1st and Elbe Army. Under their pressure and due to new orders Jizera group had to retreat to Jičín. There was a battle, in which get in almost whole Jizera group. The battle ended in the retreat and disintegration of this group. This had major importance and led ultimately to retreat across North army to Hradec Králové.
