

Abstract

Objective and scope: Gather information and materials, sort them by content, process, and integrate in one document comprising private and professional portraits of Emeritus Professors of Charles University, Faculty of Pharmacy in Hradec Králové. Record their views and opinions on professional preparation and knowledge of future pharmacists. Explore into their experience when facing the reality of historical development of Czech pharmacy education, in particular the developmental stage connected with the city of Hradec Králové. Clarify the place, role and scientific profile of these eminent persons, and try to preserve their legacy.

Methodology: Available sources containing information about the life and work of Emeritus Professors such as jubilee articles in journals and proceedings have been used to gather the necessary data. Interviews with the Emeritus Professors were required to complete the whole profile of the personalities. Sound recordings with authentic voices of the respective personalities have been taken as another output in addition to the written document.

Conclusion: This thesis has managed to depict the chronological development of pharmacist education history as well as, in the first place, private and professional portraits of Emeritus Professors of Charles University, Faculty of Pharmacy in Hradec Králové.
