Formal aspects of diploma thesis:

- Content (p. 4) page numbering is missing
- Abbreviations should be expressed in Greek and English languages
- Abbreviation PSF means Pan-Hellenic Pharmaceutical Association
- EOPPY, correctly EOPYY

Content aspects of diploma thesis:

- I consider the literature review on the topic to be modest in some aspects
- It should be also mentioned Ethniko Systima Ygeias (ESY, National Health System) by the author
- The results of the diploma thesis should be discussed for more detail
- Description in pharmacy practice in Greece is relatively insufficiently documented, e.g. there is lack of figures concerning number and distribution of pharmacies in Greek territory, number of pharmacist, number of technicians working in pharmacies, number state, chain and independent pharmacies, etc. and subsequent comparison.
- The discussion on the actual theme, e.g. "The state does not even cover the basic needs of the population for drugs" is missing.

Questions: Which advantages and disadvantages bring Greek health care system and providing pharmacy practice/pharmaceutical care in comparison with the Czech system?
