

Abstract

The thesis deals with parental responsibility and potential state intervention as an important part of family law, or in some cases civil law, which is regulated by Act No. 94/1963 Coll., on the Family (the “Family Act”), and Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code, effective from 1 January 2014. The thesis centres on an analysis of the legal regulation of parental responsibility and potential interventions, especially in the context of current case law and professional literature. In the thesis I consider the imposition of corrective measures; suspension, restriction and termination of parental rights, and necessary substitutes for family care such as foster care, protective youth and young offenders rehabilitation, adjudicated treatment in a special in-patient institution, and the cases of adoption without parental consent. The thesis also includes a comparison of the current legislation of the parental responsibility and potential interventions according to the Family Act and incoming legislation according to the Civil Code.
