

Abstract

This thesis deals with the construction of housing estate in Rychnov nad Kněžnou in the 70s of the 20th century. The construction of Travník I and Travník II, required, along with the new traffic rerouting, a rather massive reconstruction of old buildings. This thesis tries to cast light among these reconstructions, explains their reasons, and describes the construction of new housing in the district town of the Eagle mountains. The thesis is based mainly on archival materials, contemporary periodicals, and interviews with witnesses of these events. This thesis is thus a compilation of the historical data, and the opinions of ordinary people which had to leave their homes to make place for the new housing estate.
