Background: The aim of this work is to bring general awareness of cervical cancer, its creator, transmission, symptoms and treatment. It presents information about registered vaccines on the market. The aim of this study is to determine women and girls awareness of vaccination against cervical cancer, and their willingness to be vaccinated. Determine view - gynecologist vaccination against cervical cancer.

Main findings: Vaccination against cervical cancer is already included in the vaccination calendar. Not an obligatory vaccination but only as recommended vaccinations for girls between 13 and 14 years.

Conclusion: The diploma paper indicates the general awareness of the causative agent, transfer options and the prevention of cervical cancer among girls. The study found that most doctors inform girls and women about the possibility to be vaccinated. Doctors would recommend vaccination for men too.
