

Abstract

The diploma thesis „Framing of euroscepticism in the Czech daily press“ deals with political communication about the European Union realized in the Czech daily press (namely MF DNES, Právo and Hospodářské noviny) during three events which were essential for the Czech republic. It was referendum (2003), signing of Lisbon Treaty (2009) and signing of ESM (2013). It focuses on quality and Europeanisation of public debate and its changes within these events. It also investigates how eurosceptic actors and opinions are represented. It is trying to examine what are their possibilities of participating in public debate and identify attitudes of individual titles. Research methods are quantitative analysis plus frame analysis. It also treats (in theoretical part) concepts like political communication (generally and on the European level), European public sphere and also euroscepticism itself.
