Comment 2- in her work, the student writes that the total hip replacement patient was treated with electrotherapy. She should have called it physical therapy, because the patient was treated with biolamp therapy on body parts with the hematoma and scars.

However, what is missing in her theory is a description of total hip replacement, the basic types of total hip replacement, how they are secured to the bone, stability, etc. The question I expect to have answered is does the student have demonstrable knowledge of this?
